Students are prepared for the main components of the TOEIC examination by covering: listening comprehension, reading, business-oriented vocabulary review and grammar review.

PATHWAY & PARTNERSHIPS

Preparing for University demands a high level of academic English. This involves developing a strong command of academic reading, note taking and lecture skills, and of course, academic writing and research skills. The best way to demonstrate a high level of academic English is to measure these skills against an internationally recognized assessment exam. The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is known as the world's language proficiency test because it is so widely used by institutions of higher learning in Canada, the UK, Australia, New Zealand, the United States and around the world.

The GV EAP program (Canada only) helps students prepare the skills they need for entering university. Each school has a wide variety of specially designed elective classes which focus on study skills, notetaking, presentation, academic writing and research. Students who successfully complete this program will be ready to succeed at university.
