Facilities for adult students

Unique has a campus exclusively for adult students (Campus 2). Campus 2 has 9 classrooms, a student lounge and a kitchen area. There are also adult classes at Campus 1, which has study and recreational facilities for adult students.

English Plus Activities

Students can join the course as individuals or as part of a group tour. The course runs from December to April and then again from June to August.

Visits to Auckland Sky Tower, Auckland Zoo, Auckland Museum and hot pools




A Unique experience – Francisca from Chile
