ILSC-NEW DELHI

In India, the term “masala,” which means “mix,” is used to describe the spice mixtures that add such rich flavours to Indian cooking. The term could just as easily be used to describe New Delhi, India’s vibrant and bustling capital. New Delhi is a young metropolis, built upon the remnants of ancient cities.

A fascinating mix of historical monuments and modern high-tech industry, colourful nightlife and fabulous shopping and dining options, New Delhi is a feast for the senses. It is also a convenient launching point for some of India’s best tourist destinations like the Taj Mahal, Rajasthan and the majestic Himalayan Hill Stations.



SPRING

Delhi’s spring, from February to April, is sunny with warm days and cool nights. The weather can be a bit unpredictable in spring, but temperatures warm up quickly. **Holi**, the Hindu “Festival of Colours” happens in mid-March, to celebrate the spring. During Holi, the locals take to the streets for wild celebration as they throw coloured powder at one another. Late spring and early summer are the best times to visit the **Himalaya regions**, and discover a bit of **Tibetan culture**.

SUMMER

Summer (April to June) is when New Delhi hits its hottest temperatures. In May it can reach 45°C or higher, and can be marked by dramatic thunderstorms. The Amaltas trees bloom in summer, painting the city a vibrant yellow. In April, check out the **Baisakhi Festival**, a Muslim celebration with traditional dancing. Then in May, the **Buddha Hayanti** (Triple Blessed Festival) celebrates the birth of Buddha.

MONSOON

Monsoon, also called the “Rainy Season” is something unique to a few regions around the world. In July, after the dry heat of summer, temperatures start to drop and then the rain rolls in providing relief from the summer heat. India receives 80% of its yearly rainfall during this season, and although Delhi is typically drier than other parts of the country, you definitely need an umbrella. In July, check out competitions, dancing, and more at the **Mango Festival**. Later in the month, the Naga Panchami festival offers a chance to see snake charmers around the city. And in August, don’t miss the **Indian Independence day** celebrations at New Delhi’s **Red Fort**.

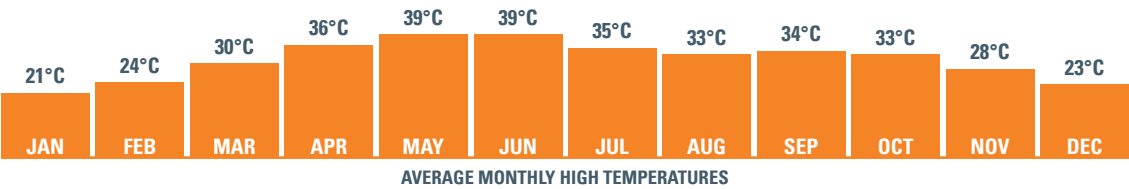
AUTUMN

Autumn is pleasant in New Delhi. In October, the rain stops, and days become warm, and the nights cool. This is a good time to get out and explore some of the region around New Delhi. October is also a month of festivals, and significant holidays.

Gandhi Jayanthi celebrates the birth of Mohandas Gandhi, and **Diwali**, the festival of lights, illuminates the city at night. Many religious figures have their own festivals this month and are celebrated through song, dance and theatre.

WINTER

December to February can get cool in Delhi as the winds blow down from the Himalayas, and though the city never receives snow, a cool fog can roll in. Students can check out the **Republic Day Parade** in January to see enormous crowds, and if they want to shop or discover the variety of Indian culture, they should definitely plan to visit the **Surajkund Crafts Mela**, a two week arts and crafts fair that happens in February.

HIMACHAL PRADESH TOUR

“HP” as it is commonly called, is a state located in the northern part of India. It is also known as the land of eternal snow because of its high altitude and year-round snow cover. During the time of the Raj, the British set up many hill stations in this northern region as a way to escape the hot Delhi summers. To this day, they remain a popular tourist destination, and a must for people to visit during India's hot summer months.

Best known as the place of exile for the Tibetan Government, the city of Dharamshala and its suburb, McLeod Ganj both attract their fair share of visitors in the summer months. The hill station of Manali is the last major settlement at the northernmost end of the Kullu Valley. Take a jeep ride up to the Rohtang Pass or explore the old town of Manali.

RAJASTHAN TOUR

Known as “The Princely State of India,” Rajasthan offers unparalleled sightseeing experiences.

Jaipur, “The Pink City,” is a capital full of stunning hilltop forts and glorious royal palaces alongside bargain-filled bazaars. Next, Jaisalmer is a giant golden sandcastle with an exotic town attached. It is the stuff of legend as its streets hide palaces of crumbling beauty and the sky spreads across the dunes of the Great Thar Desert. Imagine a safari on camelback where you watch the sun set in the desert around a fire while listening to beautiful Rajasthani music... From pink to gold to “The Blue City,” Jodhpur encloses the awesome Meherangarh Fort which looms above narrow Brahmin-blue lanes as if from a real-life movie. The scent of spices fills the air while long-mustached men pose for pictures.

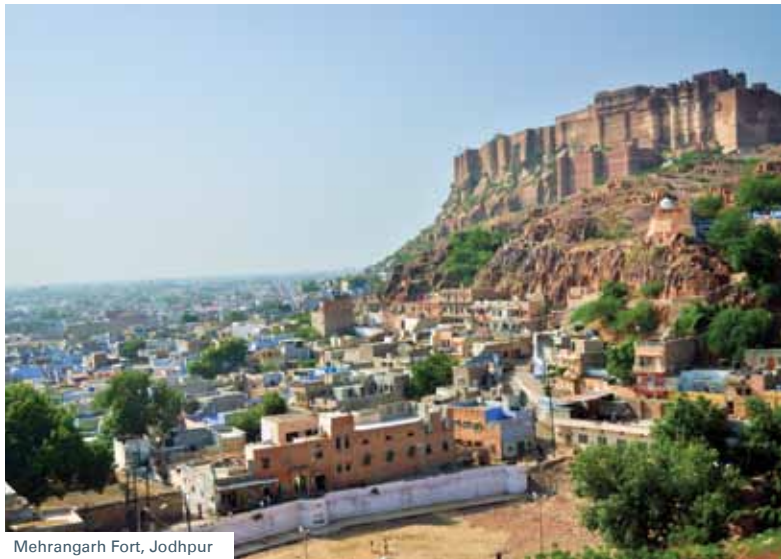

RISHIKESH, HARIDWAR, AMRITSAR TOUR

The quiet and serene village of Rishikesh, known as the “Yoga Capital of the World,” is nestled at the foothills of the Himalayan mountains. The setting is conducive to peaceful mind expansion and you can spend your time meditating or doing yoga at one of the many ashrams. In the evening, the breeze from the valley tickles the temple bells as sadhus (Hindu holy men), pilgrims and tourists undertake the nightly ganga aarti ceremony. Rishikesh is very New Age: take an intro lesson in sitar or tabla on your hotel roof; try laughing yoga; practice gong meditation; experience crystal healing; chant mantras; and listen to spiritually uplifting music as you sip Ayurvedic tea. But it’s not all spiritual. Rishikesh is where the mighty Ganges comes rushing down from the mountains, making for some great white water rafting and treks in the Himalayas.

One of the 7 Hindu Holy places in India, Haridwar has many beautiful Hindu temples nestled along the banks of the Ganges which runs through the city. Tourists and pilgrims come here to wash away their sins in order to attain Moksha and transcend the cycle of reincarnation.

Amritsar is home to Sikhism’s holiest shrine: The Golden Temple. This gold-plated place of worship shimmers in the center of its holy pool like a giant bar of gold. Some people compare it to the Taj Mahal in grandeur and the evening ceremony there is a sight to behold. You can also witness the India/Pakistan Wagah border ceremony and in contrast to the old city, enjoy slick internet cafes, exceptional restaurants known for rich cuisine, and bustling markets in Amritsar’s modern areas.

ACCOMMODATIONS

HOMESTAY LIVE LIKE A LOCAL

Homestay gives students a window into the unique culture and family life in their country of study. Some will discover friendships that last a lifetime.

You'll be surprised how quickly your speaking improves when you're immersed in English or Hindi from breakfast until bedtime. ILSC's integrated Homestay Program carefully selects families who provide a friendly, supportive and welcoming home environment for students.

Most homestay families live between 5–45 minutes from ILSC by public transit. Each family provides their student guest with a furnished private bedroom, a shared bathroom and meals (breakfast and dinner). ILSC's multilingual Student Accommodations staff monitor each home to make sure it is appropriate, and are always available to help you if any problem or issue happens to arise.

Students can choose to stay with an English or Hindi-speaking household, and can choose either a regular homestay, or a premium homestay, located in an upscale neighbourhood.

STUDENT APARTMENTS

ILSC–New Delhi's student apartments are all located within 10 minutes walking distance to the school. The apartments are furnished and are located near some excellent shopping malls, markets, movie theaters, restaurants and cultural attractions.

ADMISSIONS

- ☐ I completed my registration one month before the first day of classes
- ☐ I submitted all applicable fees
- ☐ I completed the Homestay application (if applicable)
- ☐ I obtained private medical insurance

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM CHECKLIST

- ☐ I completed all of the above requirements for general admissions
- ☐ I completed the separate internship program application

GREYSTONE COLLEGE CHECKLIST

- ☐ To be admitted to **Greystone College** prospective students must have completed their final year of general schooling (Grade 12), or have a diploma or degree from a recognized post-secondary institution or have mature student status.
- ☐ All applicants whose first language is not English must provide proof of English proficiency.
- ☐ Students must be at least 18 years old at the commencement of studies.

If the prospective student fails to meet the minimum admission requirements, neither the institution nor the student can waive the requirements. Please refer to the language requirements chart for individual program language requirements.

VISAS AND IMMIGRATION

VISITOR VISA

TOURIST VISA

Students who plan to study for less than 6* months will require a Tourist Visa. Tourist Visas are valid for single entry only and cannot be extended. Once you leave the country you must wait 2 months before you can reapply and you cannot extend your Tourist Visa in India or in a neighbouring country.

STUDY PERMIT

Students who intend to study in India for more than 6 months will require a Study Permit. Study Permits allow multiple entries, and are issued for the duration of your study, as per your letter of acceptance.

**The length of the Tourist Visa may vary depending on your country of origin. Please check with your local Indian embassy or consulate for current information and to apply for visas.*

MEDICAL INSURANCE

ILSC highly recommends that students acquire travel health coverage for the duration of their stay in India.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS TEACHER TRAINING

International students must demonstrate an upper intermediate level of English by completing our online assessment test and an arranged speaking interview, or by submitting an official test score that meets the minimum requirement for their desired program of study. Please refer to the chart for individual program language requirements.

NOTE: If you do not currently meet the language requirements, please let us know. Our English language programs available through ILSC Language Schools can help prepare you for entry into one of our Teacher Training programs.

INTERVIEW

All students planning to attend Greystone College will be required to participate in an interview in order to determine their suitability for their desired program. For non-native English speakers, the interview will also examine language ability. The interview can be conducted in person, or over the phone.
